We discuss issues and prospects of the Indian economy. Main topics are 1) how effectively economic growth has or has not enhanced social development, 2) has poverty reduced, 3) what are driving forces of economic growth and whether they are sustainable, 4) what causes jobless (unemployment) growth, 5) what are consequences of increased investment in education, 6) how globalization affected financial intermediation and stability. We also discuss a few case studies.
